Paper Topics

Directions: For this course, you will need to write <u>2</u> papers; one is due by <u>March 17th</u> and the other is due by <u>May 12th</u>. However, you can turn both in prior to their due dates if you would like. There are four possible topics that a student can write about:

- Nature vs. Nurture
 - Write Summary
 - Identify which perspective (nature or nurture) you relate to when it comes to the idea of killing and human nature. Remember to explain your reasoning. Then list a situation where an individual would use the opposite perspective than the one you relate to (nature vs. nurture).

• Egocentrism

• Parenting Styles

- Write Summary
- Please explain the emotional state of children in the 3 parenting styles discussed in the
 article and how the style could affect the child's development? Use the three processes to
 explain the development portion.

• Resilience

- Write Summary
- Why do you believe the results for conversation orientation and conformity orientation turned out the way they did? How would they encourage resilience in an individual?
 Please use examples to illustrate your reasoning.

In each paper, you will need to SUMMARIZE the article read, and then answer the questions presented by Ms. Taylor. Any questions, ask.

Please get your journal article on your selected topic from Ms. Taylor when you are ready.
